DEPLOYMENTS & SCHEDULING

As a 1099 subcontractor, you may experience gaps between deployments. While Conceras values strong working relationships with technicians and aims to re-engage proven performers, the nature of global deployments means:

- + **Deployments are project-based**, not guaranteed to be continuous
- + **Project delays can and do happen** — due to government scheduling, embassy readiness, security processing, or logistics.
- + **You may experience downtime between deployments;** consistent back-to-back work is not guaranteed
- + **We prioritize subcontractors we've worked with successfully in the past when new opportunities arise.**
- + **You are free to work with other companies** in between deployments—we support your ability to manage your own schedule.
- + **Once you accept a deployment**, you are expected to commit to the start date and remain on the project through completion. Reliable follow-through is essential to maintaining our reputation and ensuring team and mission success.

DEPLOYMENT TIMELINE & SUPPORT:

Spin-up Period: 2–3 months for onboarding, documentation, and security checks

Security Clearance: Conceras can upgrade eligible candidates from Secret to Top Secret

Passport Required: All technicians must hold a valid U.S. Passport

Deployment Locations: OCONUS—Embassy and Consulate locations

WHAT IT MEANS TO BE A 1099 SUBCONTRACTOR:

These roles are independent contractor (1099) assignments. It's essential to understand the following:

- + **Tax Responsibility:** You are responsible for self-employment taxes and reporting
- + **Deployment Timing:** Deployments are subject to change—do not resign from your current position until a deployment is 100% confirmed
- + **Invoicing:** You invoice Conceras for your hourly rate and per diem
- + **Airfare:** Paid up front by Conceras
- + **Tools:** You provide your own essential tools. *List can be provided.
- + **No Employee Benefits:** Medical, PTO, and retirement benefits do not apply
- + **Freedom & Flexibility:** Accept assignments that match your schedule—no obligation to accept every deployment
